

## Clinical Trial Scientist in The Department of Infectious Disease Immunology

### The Department

The Department of Infectious Disease Immunology houses a world leading vaccine research and discovery program directed against some of the major global infectious diseases such as tuberculosis (TB), polio and chlamydia. The Department conducts both basic and translational research and is in the absolute forefront in the international efforts to develop a novel vaccine against TB. The product portfolio comprises two TB vaccine candidates in clinical trials, a chlamydia vaccine for Phase I testing starting 2016 and two novel adjuvants in different stages of clinical development. The Department is partner in multiple leading-edge research programs aimed at understanding host-pathogen interactions and vaccine-induced protection. We collaborate closely with the Vaccine Development Department at SSI and a large number of international research institutions and are funded by e.g. the European Commission, NIH and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.

### The job

We are currently recruiting a Clinical Trial Scientist for the Human Immunology Section with an interest in vaccine and translational research. A central part of the job is coordination and implementation of the clinical R & D relating to our clinical trials with a special focus on TB and chlamydia vaccines. The work is in close collaboration with colleagues from vaccine development department, regulatory & medical affairs and external partners. Relevant training in vaccine related activities will be provided and prioritized.

### Job description:

- Design of clinical trials and translational research projects mainly within the field of vaccines
- Clinical operations activities - including liaison with external partners such as trial sponsors and investigators
- Internal consultant on safety aspects of vaccine candidates in clinical trial
- Clinical data interpretation, preparation of scientific manuscripts and presentations at international meetings incl. regulatory bodies and decision-makers
- Fundraising for clinical trials

### Qualifications:

- Relevant scientific education e.g. Medical Doctor
- Experience with clinical trials and ICH GCP
- Experience with vaccine research, infectious diseases and/or translational immunology is an advantage
- Dynamic, independent and goal orientated with strong interpersonal and communication skills (verbal and written)
- Ability to handle and prioritize multiple tasks
- Ability to work in an international environment with internal and/or external partners
- Experience in preparation of scientific papers, grant applications and scientific presentations
- Interest in pursuing a scientific career

### Terms of employment:

This is a permanent position scheduled to start December 2015, or upon agreement with the chosen candidate. Travelling activities is part of the job.

The employment is based on the collective agreement between the Ministry of Finance and AC (the organization of Academics).
